Executive Summary

Executive Summary

A concentrated effort has been made over six months to improve the overall operations of the store as outlined below and detailed In the attachments which follow;

Improvement to Operations-

The General Manager has worked with all current staff to make sure training is in place, and that brand standards are followed closely resulting an overall improvement to Operations.

Revised Staffing Schedule-

Staff was initially hired based on the requirements of the franchise for new stores (over 500 man hours during set up and training). When sufficient sales were not being generated, staff hours have been reduced, select staff were terminated, and other staff were reduced to the level where resignations occurred. The result has been a reduction of over 50% of staff hours from a high of 775 weekly hours reported July 31 to 248 hours in mid-December allowing payroll to be reduced from a high of \$13,191 to the most recent \$4,537 weekly payroll. Payroll hours have remained below 260 hours consistently since November 13 as shown in the full report.

As a percentage of sales, payroll (including manager salary but excluding payroll taxes and marketing/human resources/corporate salaries), the Payroll expense has reduced from a high of 80% of weekly sales to a low of 28% in mid-December. By now increasing sales, the goal is to further reduce this Rate to 21% of sales.

Staff Assessment-

Staff has been individually assessed with follow up one-on-one meetings with each staff member, the General Manager and corporate representatives.

The first assessment was held in October and the second assessment was held in late December. The ADP staff assessment model was utilized both times and is included in this update. All staff improved except one Manager, whose performance was not consistent over the past six months and who resigned after the assessment.

Inventory-

Inventory had not been undertaken either consistently or accurately from the initial set up and opening week. In addition, various errors in the Aloha system

Seemed to taint the inventory numbers. Over 6 months, we believe inventory reached a level exceeding \$30,000, reducing down to \$15,000 and most recently

Hovering in the \$7800 weekly inventory average where it should remain. Improved planning and ordering has helped achieve this along with a focused

And corrected approach to detailed inventory counts and inventory reporting. Now that 2023 has ended, inventory was conducted December 31 so that accounting staff can go back to July to conduct an accurate 6 month food and disposable cost analysis. Inventory reports from Aloha are being run on a timely basis as shown in this report.

Food Cost-

Food Cost has been high since opening date due to training, promotions, giveaways, waste, staff errors, customer problems, etc. And because of inventory counting problems the the cost of goods sold (food and disposables) have averaged in the 40 to 50 percent range until inventory problems were addressed. We now have reported a high of 86% to a low of 27% from our accounting department. The General Manager has reported a recent low of COGS of 21% in late December. Bottom line is that we are monitoring COGS very closely in order to get costs in line and reported accurately as we close out 2023 and enter 2024. Sample Aloha and corporate accounting reports have been included. The targeted goal is 21% to 22% range for food and disposables.

Reputation Management-

The overall ratings of Reputation Management for the initial six months by the franchisor is included which includes select platforms found on line and reported to the brand. Ratings of the Rancho store from the summer months after opening has been generally consistent each week through mid December.

Of the top 10 to 25 stores located throughout the country, the Rancho store has been consistently ranked in the "4" rating with ranges from 4.2 to 4.9 out of top rated 5.

Ranking has been shared with other stores for the most part ranging from a low of 8th out of the top 10 store groups to a high of 2nd out of the top 8 store groups.

The goal is to reach 5 in the first quarter of 2024. A summary 6 month report has been included.

Operation Inspection and Report-

UFG and Great Greek franchisor has conducted three on site inspections in addition to the original set up and training. Based on feedback, operations have improved and will continue to improve so that the Rancho store can be considered a west coast training store for the brand no later than June 2024.

Franchisor Support-

The franchisor has provided support to the Rancho store including marketing, advertising, and subsidized promotions. We look forward to continued support until the Rancho store reaches acceptable weekly revenue levels that are sustainable.

Food Plating-

Concern was raised by the franchisor during the fall of the Rancho team delivering brand acceptable plating both in store and thru 3rd party deliverables. A focused effort has been made to improve this condition so that all plating equals or exceeds the photographed menu items. This has been done thru staff training, monitoring and ongoing documentation (ie photography) of prepared/delivered food items. Pictures of select menu items have been included.

Improved Customer Reviews-

Corporate marketing staff and principals monitor comprehensive customer reviews on an ongoing basis to ensure that local on site problems are identified, addressed and corrected with the goal of minimizing or eliminating negative reviews all together going into 2024. After strategic efforts by local store staff, YELP ranking improved

To 4 star with a successful over subscribed YELP Elite week. The goal is to achieve a 5 star YELP ranking by March 31, 2024. Samples of various platform customer reviews have been included.

Marketing Promotions-

Significant marketing promotions have been undertaken since opening date based on brand leadership and nationwide efforts. Additional store specific promos have all been Provided from facebook advertising to geofencing targeted marketing offering promos to track results. Its an on–going effort with the goal of providing less free meals while incentivizing new customers with low cost promos. Store management has tracked select promos and we are working to ensure all tracking all promos are reported and tracked to assist with future activities, and to ensure correct budgeting. Select tracking has been included

Community Engagement-

From Community Day supporting a local high school sports team to providing free lunches to the 20 member Rancho Chamber Board of Directors, to a local Church program, community engagement was started in 2023. There is much more that needs to be done to ensure Great Greek becomes a local brand in the Inland Empire that patrons ns will support on an ongoing basis.

Operating Statement-

Financial analysis of each two week operating period has been reported from initial opening thru December to monitor losses. Two week losses ranged from a high of \$44,700 to a low of \$9,300 in the middle of September as shown in this report (cumulative loss of \$235,900 thru December 31 with an additional \$73,000 loss including pre launch and corporate allocation). Despite aggressive attempts to secure holiday catering contracts, the month of December ended with a \$33,000 loss before any regional or corporate allocation.

Improv	/ement	to Oper	ations

The following areas have been trained and implemented in order to improve stores overall performance.

Line built training: Line built training was a month-long project that needed to be put in place in order to ensure plating was meeting standards.

On a weekly basis we highly focused on 3-4 plates to ensure every line cook and cashier/expo knew the standards in place. (Ensure all orders left the expo window accurate was a huge focus.

Cook training: due to low sales and having to cut labor, we highly focused on ensuring all line cooks know how to safely cook while meeting the standard around quality.

Cross training: due to low sales we had to adjust schedules, this meant Gyro station/salad station cooks had to learn both lines.

Cashier to expo: due to sales we had to cut the expo position, ensuring the cashier knew how to multitask and work both stations and attend a dine in 80% + in sales was a huge focus.

Food knowledge: ensuring team members constantly taste food and know how to describe it has been a daily focus, this has helped with knowledge shared with guests.

Food management: ensuring every single store employee knows and understands the importance of minimizing mistakes, overcooking food and the importance of portioning was heavily implemented during our line-built training.

Prep team training: is utilizing tools and constantly/heavily focusing on recipe cards has ensured our food has a consistent taste.

Store walk thru: ensuring managers have a daily routine during opening, shift change, and closing have improved station validation and overall efficiency. This has given us the opportunity to cut labor. The opening manager is now opening every station, due to sales.

My comped Yelp meal was almost \$40 (entrée, drink, salad and dessert) and that's just for one person. I'm just really bummed I was limited in only getting a chicken option and was really looking forward to trying something else, but I hope The Great Greek does well and stays busy.

I have not loved rice pudding more until this moment. I came here for the gyro wrap but I left here without it and in love with something I didn't expect myself to get. The skewers were unfortunately kind of dry but dipping it in the tzatziki added a bit of moisture back. They added the right amount of cinnamon and I can honestly say it's the best rice pudding I've ever had. This place opened up a few months ago near the Victoria Gardens.

I got the great Greek gyro wrap (\$10.95) which was filled with chopped lettuce, tomatoes, red onions, tzatziki, and feta cheese; I got it with lamb meat for extra. They do ask how you prefer your meat cooked and I had asked for it to be cooked well. The chunks of lamb was still tender and the lamb taste wasn't as strong. I asked for a side of feta fries which is mozzarella and feta melted onto crispy fries with a lemon wedge. The lemon went well with the feta.

The baklava was still crispy the day after I bought it. The syrup is not too sweet and they did not go heavy-hand with the amount.

Lalso bought a gyro platter and a Four dip combo (\$15.95) sampler plate to try their appetizer selection. The gyro was tender and not salty, the meat was cut nicer and not too thin. It came with pita bread and chopped red onions.

The tzatziki was not as tangy with bits of thinly sliced cucumber and olive oil. They gave me plenty of pita bread to dip into the sauces. The tirokafteri was rich with the cream cheese, roasted peppers and feta cheese. The hummus was good along with the melitzanosalata dip which was roasted eggplants with olive oil and lemon juice.

I tried their avgolemo soup which is a lemony chicken broth with bits of chicken and rice.

The staff is nice. Plenty of parking outside and a large amount of seating inside. They also gave me a branded yelp water bottle for the event.


